### 1.1.1.1. Executive Summary

Planned Operational activities are discussed at quarterly Galong Community Liaison Group Meetings.

Planned exploration activities for the period 15 August 2023 to 14 August 2024 were restricted to field mapping and rock chip sampling south-east of the quarry. Planned drilling was not undertaken because cropping restricted time to potentially drill; unable to secure a drilling rig when the area was accessible, wet weather restricted access and kiln shutdowns restricting RAB drilling rig availability.

Bobbara Station was consulted regarding planned mapping and sampling prior to commencement of mapping and sampling to minimise potential impacts on crops .
