1.1.1.1. Executive Summary

Planned Operational activities are discussed at quarterly Galong Community Liaison Group Meetings.

Planned exploration activities for the period 15 August 2022 to 14 August 2023 were restricted to field mapping south-east of the quarry. Drilling was not undertaken because unable to secure a drilling rig when the area was accessible, with wet weather restricting access and kiln shutdowns restricting RAB drilling rig availability.

Bobbara Station Manager Matt Cummins was consulted regarding planned mapping and sampling prior to commencement of mapping and sampling to minimise potential impacts on crops .
